AN EARLY VICTORIAN CARVED PORTLAND STONE CAPITAL

removed from Piccadilly, Westminster

the leafy volutes with lion terminii centred by a fleur-de-lys on a fish-scale ground, raised on a stiff leaf collar and now presented on an associated Portland stone foot; being a capital for an attached column, the capital is ornamented on three sides and cantilevered from a cuboid masonry block at the back, some losses to the carving,

HISTORY

This spectacular capital has been salvaged from London's most famous street and dates to the 1840's.
