the six bar grate with guillotine beneath a frieze panel cast in low relief, the field of geometric design with 'mon' crysanthamum roundels, flanked by panels each containing twelve blue and white tiles, edged with reeded cast iron trim with repeating chrysanthemum segments, some damage to the tiles,
