the substantial cuboid block with a wrought iron suspension hasp to the top, and vertical channels cut to each short side,

HISTORY

Although generally described as stones used to apply pressure during the manufacture of cheese, we suspect that this weight could have originated in any number of industrial settings: not specifically cheese. Every derrick, Scotsman crane, gantry and press would have counterbalancing weights such as this – operating as they did without hydraulics.
