### HISTORY

This mask can be supplied in composition stone, the mouth drilled for a fountain mask - see 24611

Alexander Pope gives us one of the earliest personifications of London's great river:

*"Old Father Thames advanced his reverend head;*

*His tresses dropp'd with dews, and o'er the stream*

*His shining horns diffused a golden gleam:*

*Grav'd on his arm appear'd the moon that guides*

*His swelling waters and alternate tides:*

*The figur'd streams in waves of silver roll'd,*

*And on her banks Augusta rose in gold."*
