

AN ENGLISH RECONSTITUTED STONE SEMI-LOBED CAMPANA URN

In the manner of Thomas Hope (1769-1831)

the body with an everted rim and mask-and-loop handles cast in relief with Apollo Citharaedus and Genius and raised on a socle and block foot together with a square section pedestal,
