HISTORY

1 Palace Street was built in 1861 as The Palace Hotel. Next door to Buckingham Palace it served for many years as the chosen preferred lodgings for Queen Victoria's guests. Later renamed Noble House it became offices and was until recently home to the Department for International Development.

Currently, this grand building is being comprehensively redeveloped into 72 prestigious apartments – the prime flats, with views over the gardens of Buckingham Palace, are selling for £30million.
