HISTORY

Partners since 1846, the Corneau brothers, Alfred (1825-1886) and Emile (1826-1906), settled by 1859 in the Petit-Bois district in Charleville. They specialised in finely cast decorative ironwork and were known for their production of magnificent umbrella stands, benches, vases, and funeral crosses. By the 1890's they were employing 300 people. Albert Deville (1844-1913), son-in-law of Alfred Corneau took the foundry on into the 20th Century- later renaming it the Deville Foundry.
