EDGAR JAMES MAYBERY (A. SIMES) 1887 - 1964)

Painter, water colorist, and etcher was born in Newport, Wales in 1887. His considerable talent led to early studies that were completed in London at the South Kensington School. By his mid thirties he was a member of the Royal Cambrian Society and the Royal West of England Academy. He died at Pwllheli in North Wales
