From the facsimile edition printed in 1978 by the Curwen Press Edward Lear began his career as a zoological illustrator, working in the Parrot House at London Zoo. This resulted in the publication of *Illustrations of the family of Psittacidae, or parrots, the greater part of them species hitherto unfigured* in 1832. The first plates for the book were issued in 1830 when he was still only 18.
