HISTORY

A finely executed piece of country furniture and particularly rare being made entirely, bar the back-boards, from solid, thick-cut Yew (one would typically expect oak). The finesse of the arch-top panels and the choice of timber may suggest that the piece was 'Estate made', and the squat proportions and quarter-columns indicate an origin of Wales, or the North-East of England.
