Vanity Fair Portrait, 1909

A Framed chromolithograph by WHO picturing Mr Walter Winans, American marksman, hunter and artist. Author *The Art of Revolver Shooting*, Winans owned hunting and shooting rights to 250,000 acres in the Scottish Highlands across Glen Strathfarrar, Glen Cannich and Glen Affric. In 1884 he attempted to prosecute a Scotsman, Muirdoch Macrae, for grazing a lamb on the ancestral lands of Clan McCrae but owned in law by Winans. The failure of Winans' prosecution established the right to roam which was a key element in opening British parklands to the public.
