HISTORY

Vauxhall, London seems originally to have been part of the extensive Manor of South Lambeth, which was held in the 13th century by the de Redvers family. The name *Vauxhall* (Fauxhall) is derived from Falkes de Bréauté, the second husband of Margaret, widow of Baldwin de Redvers.
