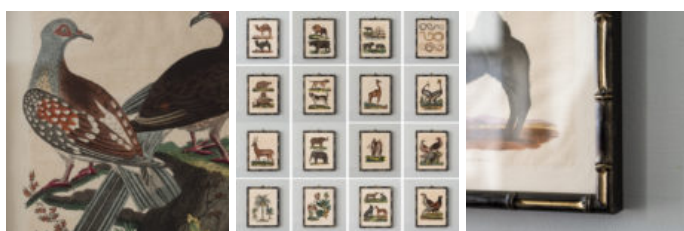
WILLIAM SMELLIE NATURAL HISTORY COPPER-ENGRAVINGS,
