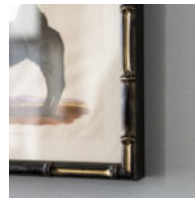
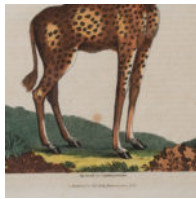

## HISTORY
